CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – ALL COMPETITIONS

It is the riders' responsibility to know the rules under which they compete

- Rules:** This event will be conducted under the *EA Dressage Competition Rules* effective 1st January 2008 (amended 1st January 2009) and where applicable the *FEI Rules for Dressage Events 23rd Edition* effective 1st January 2008, subject to any amendments or inclusions
- Horses** must be registered with, and owners and riders must be financial members of, the Equestrian Australia (EA) in their State of residence, or if not Australian, with their respective national federation.
- Riders** must be twelve years of age or over on the first day of the competition. Pony Dressage Riders may compete from the beginning of the year they turn 10.
- Each** horse entered must have the same rider as nominated on the entry form for all competitions at the Championships. Any change of rider from the rider nominated on the entry form, must be notified before the Championships commence.
- Horses** cannot be substituted.
- Eligibility of horses:** Horses may only compete in two consecutive levels at the event but no more than three tests, which may include a freestyle, may be ridden on a single day. Horse may not be entered for more than ONE freestyle level at the event.
- Balloting:** All Competitions will be kept to a maximum of 35 but these numbers may be reduced at the Organising Committee's discretion. The Organising Committee will not be dividing competitions, but instead will be balloting based on official scores achieved for each horse at each level entered in the 12 months preceding close of entries. A minimum of one official score for each level entered must be supplied, horses will be balloted based on descending order of scores, entries which supply no official score for balloting will be placed on the bottom of the list with priority given to TDI members and sponsors. If more than 35 entries are received for any one competition a reserve list will be issued with the draw and these riders will be advised as places become available.
- Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 24 hours of the completion of the event. In such cases the organising committee reserves the right to retain up to 30% of the entry fees. Entry fees will be refunded in full for scratchings before the closing date and for riders on the reserve list who are not offered a start in a competition. The administration fee will not be refunded under any circumstances after close of entries.
- The Organising Committee** reserves the right to accept and/or reject entries.
- A copy of the Draw/Start list** will be posted after the close of entries.
- GST information.** Toowoomba Dressage Inc is not registered for GST and no GST has been charged in entry fees.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – FREESTYLE COMPETITIONS

- The organising committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry in the Freestyle.
- Freestyle entry fee is absolutely NON refundable after close of entries under any circumstances.
- The organising committee reserves the right to ballot if necessary in all freestyles. Refer condition 7.
- It is the responsibility of all competitors in the Freestyles to provide the CD and to ensure that the music is recorded at the correct sound level.
- Ponies will be permitted to enter Freestyle competitions up to Advanced level but will not be awarded separate prizes.
- Horses/ponies may only enter ONE freestyle level at the event.

WELFARE OF THE HORSE – CODE OF CONDUCT

The Federation Equestre Internationale (FEI) and Equestrian Australia (EA) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's/EA's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. The FEI/EA urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise. A full copy of the Code can be obtained from the FEI, Avenue Mon-Repos 24, CH-1000, Lausanne 5, Switzerland. The code is available in English and French. The code is also available on the FEI's website: www.horsesport.org.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Toowoomba Dressage Members who are entered in the event must be prepared to assist with the running of the competitions, or provide a volunteer worker, where required, ie pencilling, gear check, setting up arenas, test running etc. Members who refuse to volunteer to work, or fail to complete their allocated task, may have their membership discount privilege rescinded at future events by the committee.

Bridle numbers: All Queensland dressage horses have been allocated a bridle number. This number must be quoted on the entry form. Interstate horses will be allocated a temporary bridle number and will be required to supply their own equipment for this.

Prize Money: Where prize money is given place winners will receive their prize money by cheque in the mail following the competition. The OC reserves the right to reduce the prize money paid to first place only for any competition which has fewer than 5 entries.

Stabling must be booked and paid for with entries. There will be a large number of safe undercover stables available under the M & S Building and Lake Pavilion as well as a number of extra large panelled yards under the Cattle Pavilion. Stables and yards WILL be allocated. A copy of the stable plan allocation will be sent out with the official draw. Bedding is supplied on the grounds and in the stables, additional bedding can be added or purchased from the fodder merchant.. Stables and yards MUST be left in a clean state upon departure. Riders/competitors of stables left unclean on departure will be charge a \$50 cleaning fee per stable.

Camping. Onsite powered camping is available throughout the grounds. Camping must be booked and paid for with entries and will NOT be allocated but available on a first in first served basis.

Catering A range of catering will be available at the competition venue throughout the event.
